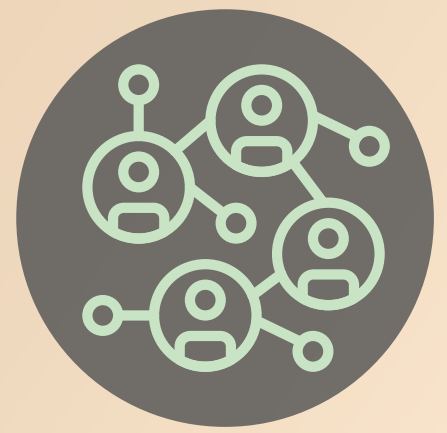


Community Cultural Wealth
